We are seeking hard-working, fun, energetic, and English-Japanese bilingual staff of any nationality.

Basic qualifications:

- Age 18 or older
- Available for all training and all camp days (see detailed schedule below)
- Capable and comfortable communicating in English and Japanese
- Serious dedication to helping kids have a blast and make the most of their camp experience

Pluses, but not requirements:

- Previous experience working with kids in a camp environment
- Outdoor experience (hiking, camping, etc.)
- Teaching or leadership experience in outdoor settings

Available Positions

Mirai no Mori camp team consists of 3 different positions: team leader, support staff, and activity leader. We will assign your position after getting your preference.

<u>Team leader</u>: Team leaders will have 5-8 campers in their own team to supervise. They are responsible for creating a safe and fun environment for all campers as well as providing individual care for each camper in their team.

<u>Support staff</u>: Support staff lay the foundation to make camp run smoothly. These staff will be responsible for camp activity preparations. They will also support team leaders and interact with campers, helping them to have a great time.

Activity leader: Activity leader is in charge of conducting activities in a way that is fun and meaningful for campers. This person will



welcome campers as well as team leaders into an English friendly environment, which is one of the Mirai no Mori core values.

Camp Staff are paid 10,000 JPY per day, with training days paid at half salary. NPO Mirai no Mori will provide full room and board, as well as cover transportation between the Tokyo / Kanto area and the camp sites.
