

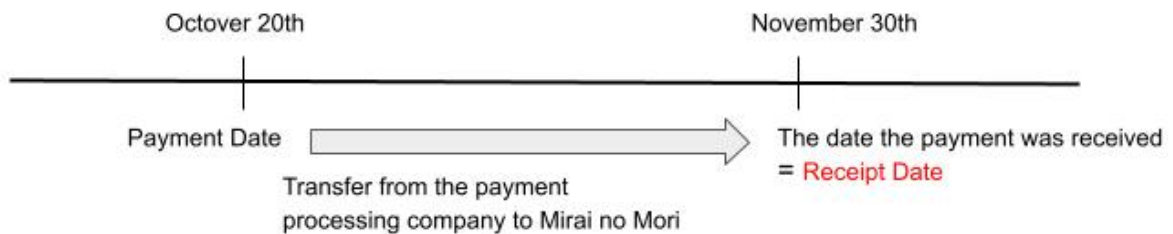
【Notice Regarding Donation Receipt Dates】

At NPO Mirai no Mori, starting from November 2024, we have changed the "receipt date" that will be indicated on donation receipts. This change applies to donations made using credit cards or PayPal. There are no changes to the receipt dates for donations made via Japan Post Bank or cash.

Until October 31, 2024 (referred to as "previous method" below)

For donations made using credit cards and PayPal, the "receipt date" was recorded as the date the payment was received in Mirai no Mori's bank account by the payment processing company. As a result, there was often a time difference of one to two months between the donor's payment date and the receipt date indicated on the donation receipt.

Example: If a credit card payment was made on October 20, the receipt date could be in November or December.



From November 1, 2024 (referred to as "new method" below)

From November 2024 onward, for donations made using credit cards and PayPal, the actual payment date will be recorded as the "receipt date" on the donation receipt.

Example: If a credit card payment was made on October 20, the receipt date will be October 20.



Regarding Donation Receipts for Donations made by Credit cards and PayPal for 2024

- For payments made by October 31, 2024, the receipt dates will be recorded using the previous method.
- For payments made after November 1, 2024, the receipt dates will be recorded using the new method.

To All Monthly Supporters

For those registered as monthly supporters, the receipt date indication will differ as follows:

For the payment of October 2024: Based on the previous method, the receipt date will be November 29 (the date the payment processing company deposits the funds).

For the payment of November 2024: Based on the new method, the payment date will be the receipt date of your recurred donation date.

As a result, the November certificate will show **two receipt dates**; however, this is not an error. We appreciate your understanding.
